“WHOEVER HAS MY COMMANDMENTS AND OBSERVES THEM IS THE ONE WHO LOVES ME”

Today’s Gospel continues Jesus’ words to his disciples at the Last Supper. As he prepares them for his departure, Jesus offers reassurance: although he will leave, he will not abandon them. Instead, he promises to send the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, who will remain with them and keep them united to him.

Jesus, the first Advocate, will send “another Advocate,” the Spirit of truth, who will guide and defend the disciples. While Jesus returns to the Father, the Holy Spirit will stay with them, helping them understand the deep unity between the Father and the Son, and their own place within that communion. Through the Holy Spirit, the disciples will come to know God more fully, while the world that does not believe remains unable to receive this truth.

Mientras Jesús regresa al Padre, el Espíritu Santo permanecerá con ellos, ayudándoles a comprender la profunda unidad entre el Padre y el Hijo, y su propio lugar dentro de esa comunión. Por medio del Espíritu Santo, los discípulos llegarán a conocer más plenamente a Dios, mientras que el mundo que no cree no puede recibir esta verdad.
