THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST, JUNE 7, 2026 *I AM THE LIVING BREAD THAT CAME DOWN FROM HEAVEN*

Today's Gospel from John follows the multiplication of the loaves and fishes, a "sign" that leads into Jesus' teaching. After witnessing the miracle, the crowd seeks Him again, but struggles to understand His message. Jesus reveals that He is the Bread of Life, sent by the Father, like a new manna that gives eternal life.

Though the crowd finds His words difficult especially about eating His flesh and drinking His blood Jesus is pointing to a deeper truth: an intimate union with Him. This is the heart of the Eucharist, where Christ is truly present. By receiving Him, we are united with Him, share in His life, and are sent to be His presence in the world.

Jesús revela que Él es el Pan de Vida, enviado por el Padre, como un nuevo maná que da la vida eterna.

Aunque la multitud encuentra difíciles sus palabras especialmente sobre comer su carne y beber su sangre Jesús está señalando una verdad más profunda: una unión íntima con Él. Este es el corazón de la Eucaristía, donde Cristo está verdaderamente presente. Al recibirlo, nos unimos a Él, participamos de su vida y somos enviados a ser su presencia en el mundo.

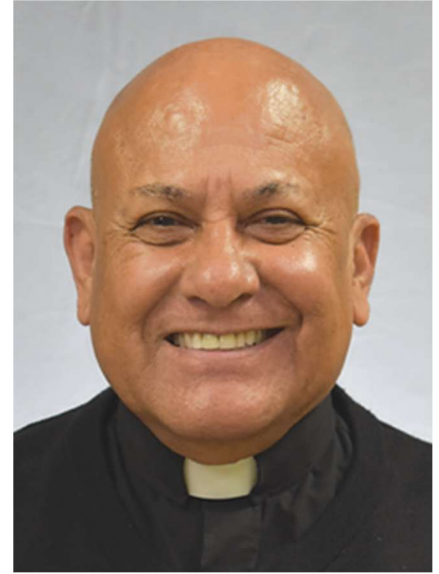


WELCOME BACK FR. HENRY CARMONA (FR. JHONNATAN'S UNCLE)!
